HISTORY

For more than a century, Fairmont Hotel Macdonald has effortlessly delivered timeless luxury in the heart of downtown Edmonton. Nestled upon the North Saskatchewan River Valley, the hotel's charm and ever-evolving elegance has earned it the spotlight as one of the city's most sought-after locations.

The Grand Trunk Pacific Railway Company opened Fairmont Hotel Macdonald on July 5, 1915. Built as an early 20th-century railway hotel, Edmonton's Châteauesque-styled building was designed to serve the passengers of Canada's then-expanding rail network into Alberta. Upon its opening in the summer of 1915, guests would depart train cabins for hotel rooms at what was deemed the grand "Chateau on the River," marking the beginning of a legacy of elegance and unparalleled hospitality in Edmonton.

Today, the celebrated hotel has reimagined its rooms, dining venues, event spaces, and Fairmont Gold – the property's exclusive and personalized boutique experience. Another stunning chapter for Edmonton's forever landmark begins now.

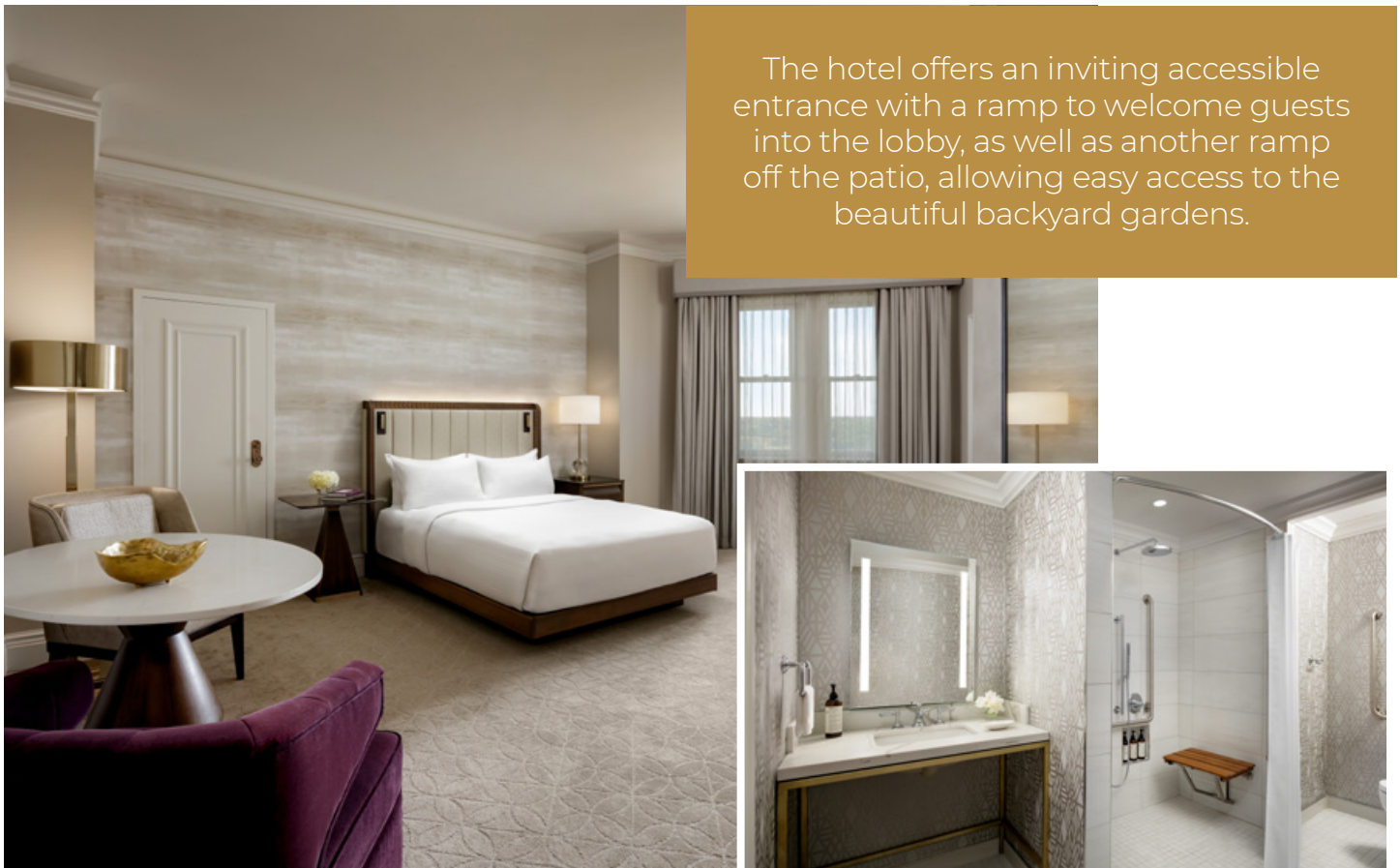

KING EDWARD VII SUITE

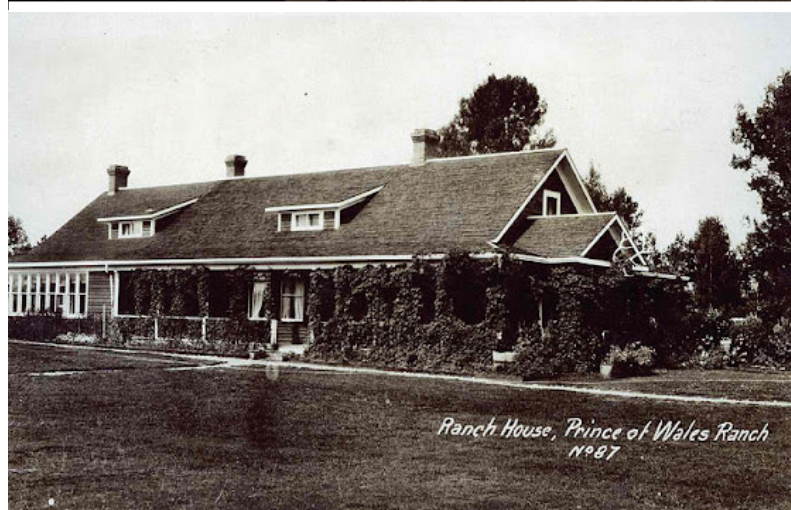
This unique bi-level suite is detailed with luxurious amenities and decor that honour its distinguished namesake, offering a regal experience. The first level features a spacious living area and a half bath, while the upstairs reveals a bedroom retreat, complemented by a bathroom with marble countertops and sophisticated European-style shower.

In 1919, then titled as The Prince of Wales, King Edward travelled to Alberta where it has been stated that the province's "space, tranquility and apparent freedom captured [his] imagination". While he was in Edmonton, he stayed with us at Fairmont Hotel Macdonald, but he soon found more rustic accommodations for future visits. On his 1919 visit, he purchased a cattle ranch in the Alberta foothills that he named E.P. Ranch.

King George stated, "the free, vigorous, hopeful spirit of western [Canada] not only inspires me, but makes me feel happy and at home". And we strive to ensure our guests experience that same sense of comfort.

CHARLES MELVILLE HAYES ROOM



Charles Melville Hays, General Manager of the Grand Trunk Railway, played a key role in establishing Canada's renowned railway hotels, including Fairmont Hotel Macdonald. On his return journey from the United Kingdom to Canada, carrying furniture for the opening of the Château Laurier in Ottawa, Hays tragically died on April 15, 1912, in the sinking of the Titanic.

SIR WINSTON CHURCHILL SUITE

The Winston Churchill Suite is a luxurious bi-level suite that features a naturally lit seating area, perfect for relaxation or visiting with company. During his stay with us in 1929, Sir Winston Churchill wrote a heartfelt letter to his wife, Clementine, expressing his fondness for Edmonton and Canada as a whole. It is well known that during his railway travel across the country in the summer of 1929, Churchill was so captivated by the Canadian prairies that while still in Alberta, he wrote another letter to Clementine, musing over the idea of retiring from politics to settle in Western Canada. While he never did, Churchill continued to visit for years to come.

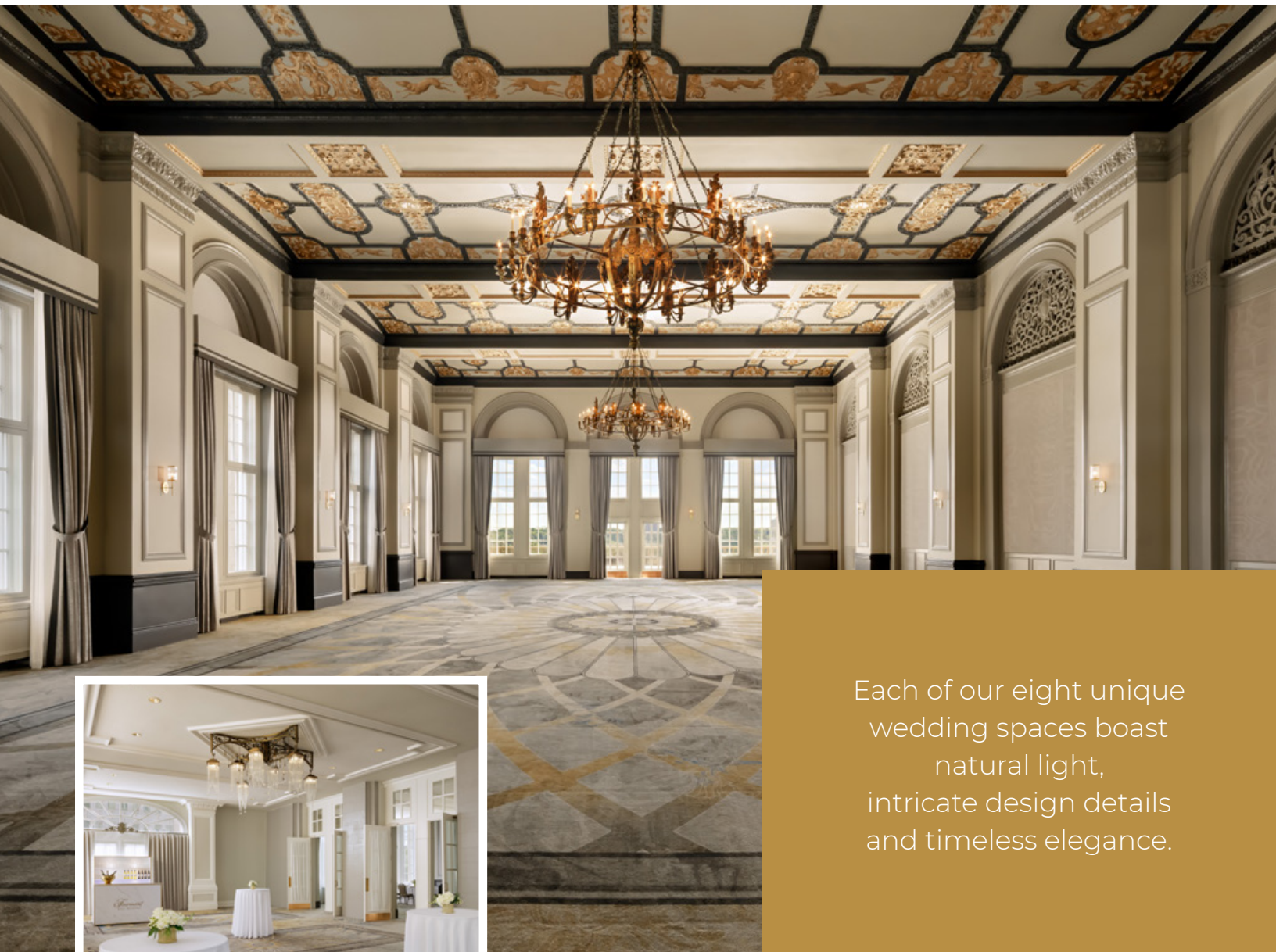

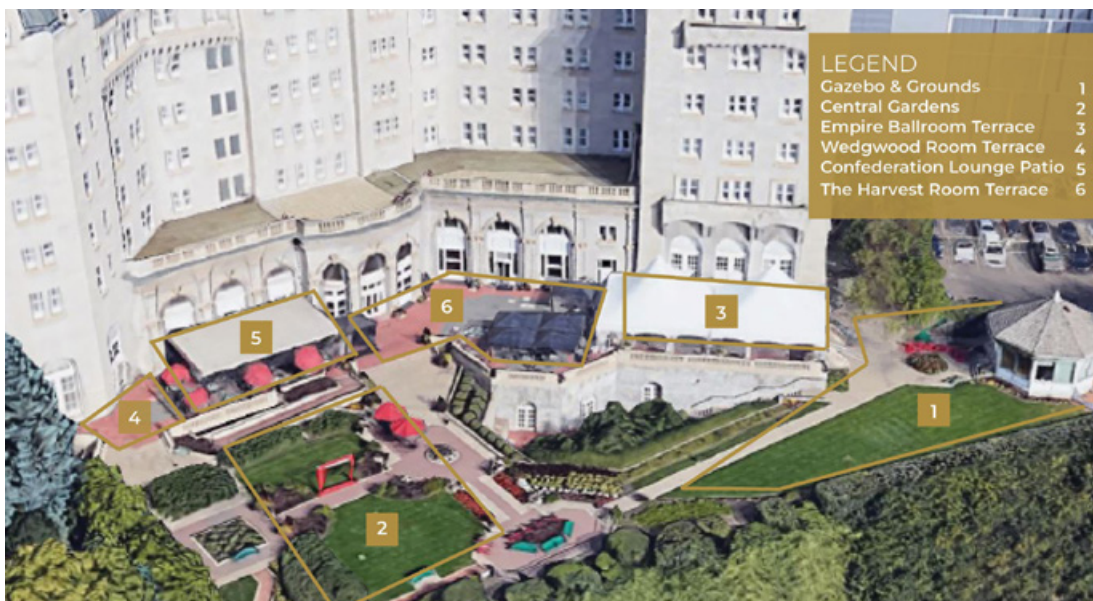
